This memorandum is in response to an email from Mr. Mike McGee of your office which transmitted and endorsed the following documents:

- A Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT) workplan, dated November 23, 2020 for Fixed Price Variable Scope (FPVS) Contracting under Special Experimental Project No. 14 (SEP-14). The workplan would only apply to Job No. J6P3543, slated for a Spring 2021 letting. Attached to the workplan was a document titled "FPVS Job No. J6P3543 Attachments," which includes Example Pay Items, Contract Award and Management, Site Locations, and Example FPVS Special Provisions; and
- 2. A December 1, 2020 cover letter from the FHWA Missouri Division Office to the FHWA Headquarters, transmitting and requesting approval of the SEP-14 workplan.

MoDOT proposes to use FPVS on a project for the installation of Seal Coat (also known as "chip seal") along various routes in Franklin County, Missouri.

## For this project:

- 1. MoDOT develops estimated quantities for the pay items in the project that will deliver the budget amount that is included in the project specifications.
- 2. Locations of the work are established in priority order in the project specifications.
- 3. MoDOT advertises the project through its traditional bidding processes.
- 4. The contractor will bid unit prices for the pay items and submits their bids through traditional bidding processes.
- 5. MoDOT awards the contract to the lowest responsive bidder.

6. Once the project has been awarded, the MoDOT construction office would then manage the contract by using a change order to adjust the contract quantities upward or downward to reach, but not exceed the budgeted amount.

Additional details may be found in the SEP-14 workplan.

MoDOT's SEP-14 workplan for the use of FPVS Contracting is satisfactory. You may consider this project approved for evaluation under SEP-14.
