





- Focuses on developing and deploying grassroots innovations through the use of Technical Advisory Groups










### State Transportation Innovation Council

The Pennsylvania State Transportation Innovation Council (STIC) facilitates the rapid implementation of proven, well-researched and documented state, regional, national and international technologies, tactics, techniques and any other innovations that are new to Pennsylvania. The STIC also supports the implementation of the <u>Federal Highway Administration's Every Day Counts (EDC)</u> Initiatives ©.

The <u>STIC is comprised of various stakeholders</u> state and federal agencies, local governments, research organizations and industry partners working together to pursue specific innovations. The <u>STIC</u> meets three times a year and all <u>business</u> meetings are open to the public.

<u>Ischnical Advisory Groups (TAGs)</u> assist the STIC in selecting innovations that should be developed for implementation and promoted. The TAGs evaluate the potential benefits and uses of an innovation, and guide it through the <u>Innovation</u> <u>Development Process</u>.

Selected innovations are developed for deployment and promoted to become standard practice within the transportation community. Beyond deploying at the statewide or regional level in Pennsylvania, the <u>STIC assists local governments</u> to deliver a modern and high-quality transportation system to the citizens of the commonwealth at all levels government.
