¹ Table SF-12A shows capital outlay for the Interstate, Arterial, and Collector systems by area and improvement type. This table does not include expenditures for roads functionally classified as local. Entries for some States may include estimates. Data reported for urban areas include both small urban and urbanized areas.

² In some instances, the subcategories group a number of improvement types. New Construction includes both New Route and Relocation. 3R includes Minor Widening, Restoration, Rehabilitation, and Resurfacing.

Bridge Work includes New Bridge, Bridge Replacement, Major Bridge Rehabilitation, and Minor Bridge Rehabilitation. Safety and other includes Safety, Traffic Operations, TSM and Environmentally Related improvement types.
