3/ Collection expenses in many States include service charges deducted by county and local collectors.

4/ The distributions shown include both specific dedications and the prorated share of motor-vehicle and motor-carrier revenue distributions from common funds with multiple revenue sources.

5/ Includes expenditures for county roads under State control.

6/ Some allocations for local general purposes may have been used in part for highways.

7/ Includes only allocations for specific nonhighway purposes.

8/ Gross allocations of highway-user revenues to State general funds were reduced by appropriations for highways from State general funds. These amounts are included with allocations for State highway purposes.
