6/ The difference between Obligations Outstanding End of Year on the 2004 LGB-2 (\$492 million) and the Obligations Outstanding Beginning of Year on the 2005 LGB-2 (\$67 million) is due to the purchase of the Chicago Skyway Bridge by a private corporation
