



FHWA Toll Facilities Report

- The Highway Performance Monitoring System (HPMS) .
- HPMS provides data that reflects the extent, condition, performance, use, and operating characteristics of the Nation's highways.
- It was developed in 1978 as a national highway transportation system database.
- It includes limited data on all public roads, more detailed data for a sample of the arterial and collector functional systems, and certain statewide summary information.

FHWA Toll Facility Report

- A Toll Facility can be characterized as roadway where you see a different pavement and incorporates portions where a toll is not charged.
- Toll Facilities, whether roads, bridges or tunnels , begin when the roadway is funded /maintained by a different entity.
- A Toll Facility continues until the roadway is maintained by another entity, whether it is the original or another entity.

FHWA Toll Facilities Report

- The Toll Facility Report contains selected information regarding the Physical location and attributes of toll facilities in the United States.
- Data is provided to FHWA by the States and/or various toll authorities regarding toll facilities in operation, financed, or under construction as of January 1 of the reported year.
- The Data is collected and reported every two years.
- Participation occurs on a voluntary basis.

Toll Facilities Report Includes:

- Name, financing or operating authority, location and termini, feature crossed, length, and road system for toll roads, bridges, tunnels, and ferries that connect highways;
- The direction of toll collection;
- The type of electronic toll collection system, if available;
- Whether the facility is part of the National Highway System (NHS); and
- Limited financial and fee information.

FHWA Toll Facilities Report

The Report is organized into five parts.

- Parts 1 and 3 of the table include the Interstate System route numbers for toll facilities, including toll bridges, roads and tunnels, located on the Dwight D. Eisenhower National System of Interstate and Defense Highways.
- Parts 2 and 4 of the table include a functional system identification code for non-Interstate System toll bridges, roads, and tunnels.
- Part 5 includes vehicular toll ferries.

Other Toll Facility Data Bases

- FHWA Office of Innovative Program Delivery collects and maintains Toll Facility Data in an Excel Database.
 - Database is used to publish a white paper entitled *Current Toll Road Activity in the U.S.: A Survey and Analysis*.
 - Paper is prepared by Parsons Brinckerhoff and published every two years.
 - Database is not available to the Public via the internet.

Other Toll Facility Data Base

- International Bridge Tunnel and Turnpike Association (IBTTA) has their own Toll Facility Database which is currently being redesigned.
 - Narrowed their list of data items from 200 to about 30 due to perceived necessity and difficulty of collection.
 - Based on a revision of FHWA's Toll Facility Report.

Future Enhancements

- Automation of Data Input Form through the Office of Highway Policy Information Data Portal.
- Integration of Finance, Toll Facility Report and Innovative Program Delivery's data into a single data base.
