We request that you submit the above documents by November 22, 2013. Failure to comply with this request may result in utility adjustment/relocation delays, highway contractor delays and/or claims, which could become the responsibility of your company pursuant to current regulations. Please enclose a statement with your submittal indicating the number of calendar days it will take to complete your construction after you have been authorized to proceed.
