Table 4B provides obligations of the Highway Bridge Program funds by State, subcategory and population. Funding subcategories are shown as:

- 20% ON/OFF SYSTEM.....Optional 20% of funds for obligation on bridges either on or off the Federal-aid Highway System
- 15% OFF SYSTEM.....Mandatory 15% of funds for obligation on bridges off the Federal-aid Highway System
- 65% ON SYSTEM.....Mandatory 65% of funds for obligation on bridges on the Federal-aid Highway System
