This is in reference to Ms. Melinda Urban's November 24, 2009 e-mail that forwarded an SEP-14 work plan on behalf of the Clear Creek County and the Colorado Department of Transportation. The County proposes to use a fixed budget/best value evaluation and selection process for a project to pave the existing Bakerville to Loveland Basin Recreational Trail to provide bicyclists a route from the Bakerville interchange to US-6 and Loveland Pass.

The project will be bid as lump sum contract in the amount of \$440,000.00 and will be awarded to the proposer who provides the best value for the fixed budget. The best value will be the proposer who provides the most paving length as measured by the total station length.

This project is approved for evaluation under SEP-14. We agree that an initial/final evaluation report is appropriate for this project.
