







Virginia Inland Port



- The Virginia Inland Port (VIP) is located 220 miles northwest of Norfolk in Front Royal, VA, across 161 acres
- Handled over 32,179 containers in 2013
- On-site rail service by Norfolk Southern with fiveday-a-week rail service between the VIP and the marine terminals in Hampton Roads
- Direct interstate access to I-81 and I-66
