


MPO PERSPECTIVE

Working with multiple state DOTs on freight planning and coordination



Kansas City region

- Two states
- Two FHWA divisions
- 8 counties in the MPO area
 - (4 in Kansas and 4 in Missouri)
- 119 cities
- 1.9+ million people
- 4,400 square miles
- More than 100 BBQ restaurants



Freight movement

- Serviced by 5 of the 7 Class 1 Railroads
- 4 intermodal hubs
- Largest U.S. rail center by tonnage
- Connected by 4 major national interstates
- Located on the largest navigable inland waterway
- Airport that moves more air cargo than any air center in a 6 state region



Freight movement

Cargo can reach 85% of the U.S. population within 2 days or less




Bistate planning

- Cooperation










Freight planning initiatives

 - Argentine Flyover Rail Crossing

- Creation of KC SmartPort, Inc.
 - Industry Outreach
- Technology Investments:
 - Trade Data Exchange
 - C-TIP (FHWA's Cross Town Improvement Project)
 - Kansas City Scout
 - Operation Green Light







New freight planning initiatives

- Central Plains Heartland Freight Technology Plan
 - Heartland Civic Council
 - 5 States (IA, IL, KS, MO, NE)
 - 6 TMAs (Des Moines IA, St. Louis MO/IL, Wichita KS, Springfield MO, Omaha NE, and Kansas City)
- Regional Freight Study
 - 15 counties
 - 3 Class 1 railroads
 - Rural and Urban
 - 2 DOTs


