


2018 Global Logistics Costs by Mode or Function (US\$ Billions)






2018 Trucking & Total Logistics Costs for Key Regions and Countries (US\$ Billions)






U.S. Transportation Spends of Domestic Shippers



The Digitalization of Domestic Transportation Management


A plethora of technology solutions have come to market over the past three years to augment traditional TMS systems and automate freight brokerage operations. These tend to fall into four groups:

- Account Management Automation
- Capacity Intelligence and Load Execution
- Visibility and Exception Management
- Back Office Automation

Many data entry and manual processes will be eliminated by artificial intelligence and machine learning, improved transportation network systems/application interfaces, and improved data mining and analysis.
