





Focus Area 4: Responding During Long-Term Infrastructure Outages

"...These efforts should be fully integrated into an updated national response architecture and new 'cross-sector' Emergency Support Function...emphasize the seamless integration of public, private sector, and volunteer organization actions to stabilize critical lifelines and establish the coordinating structures, communications, information exchange, and decision making that optimize getting the right capability to the right place at the right time for the disaster survivor..."
