





Freight Movement in Arizona – Originating or Destined for Arizona

- <u>I-10 West</u> connects to largest trading partner; California
- I-10 between Phoenix and <u>Tucson</u> is an important Intrastate Freight Corridor
- <u>I-17</u> is primary N-S Freight Corridor connecting to I-40 and beyond (Utah)





From Freight Plan to Truck Parking

Early Coordination with MPOs Set the Stage

- Coordinated Freight Plans
- Highways vs Urban Arterials
- Developed a formula for CUFC Designation

State Freight Advisory Committees (FAC) Involvement

- Engaged Critical Public and Private Stakeholders
- Arizona FAC Advised Development of Freight Plan

ADOT Commitment to Truck Parking

• Set aside \$10M for future truck parking project

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

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
Future Tasks and Implementation


