

- Hours of Service (HOS) (FMCSA Regulations)
- International Registration Plan (IRP)
- International Fuel Tax Agreement (IFTA)
- Oversize/Overweight Permitting



#### **Utility Companies**

HOS – Exempt; Contractors are not exempt.
