Table 5F provides obligations for the National Highways Performance Program by state, program funding subcategory, and population.	
Funding subcategories are shown as:	
ANNUAL LIMITATION.....	Obligation limitation that is available for one fiscal year used to obligate apportioned funds and allocated funds subject to such obligation limitation by law. The annual limitation provided for apportioned funds is also known as formula obligation limitation. Almost all obligation limitation for the Federal-aid Highway Program is annual limitation.
SPECIAL LIMITATION.....	Obligation limitation that is available for more than one fiscal year (either multi-year or available until used) used to obligate funds for certain programs subject to such obligation limitation by law. Under the FAST Act, only research programs receive special limitation (available until used). In the past, a limited number of other programs received special limitation.
BRIDGE PENALTY.....	Obligation limitation that is available for one fiscal year used to obligate apportioned funds and allocated funds subject to such obligation limitation by law. The annual limitation provided for apportioned funds is also known as formula obligation limitation. Almost all obligation limitation for the Federal-aid Highway Program is annual limitation.
Areas are defined as:	
Rural	Areas not included within an urban area.
Small Urban.....	Areas with populations greater than 2,500 and less than 200,000.
Urbanized.....	Areas with populations greater than 200,000.
Other.....	Projects falling outside of Rural, Small Urban, or Urbanized (such as Statewide where the geographical information is not known).
