**ACTION REQUIRED**

Attached for your signature are letters to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives transmitting the Report to Congress on the obligated and unobligated balances of funds provided for Federal-aid highways and highway safety construction programs.

**SUMMARY**

The Report to Congress was required in the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU). Under the Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Act (MAP-21), the Secretary is to make future reports available to the public in a user-friendly format on the Internet. Unlike SAFETEA-LU, MAP-21 does not contain a specific requirement for future reports to be sent to Congress. A copy of the report is attached for your review. I also have attached letters to transmit the report to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives. This report will also be posted on the Federal Highway Administration's Web site.

**RECOMMENDATION**

I recommend that you sign the attached letters transmitting the Report to Congress on Obligations and Unobligated Balances for Federal-aid Highways and Highway Safety Construction Programs for Fiscal Year 2012.



