Isaac Puente, 20, was driving south when he struck the guardrail near the Loop 410 exit, police said. The rail went through the engine block and cab and out the back.

Two witnesses pulled the driver to safety, police said. Puente's leg was broken in the crash, but he was otherwise believed to be fine.

All of freeway's southbound lanes were momentarily shut, with traffic diverted to Loop 410 while a crew worked to clear the scene.
