For this webinar, we will hear from two winning local agencies who developed innovations that solved problems in their maintenance programs. These innovations improved processes, saved time and money and increased safety for their workers and their community.

Special guest speakers:

- **Corby Lewis** from the South Manheim Township, Schuylkill County, PA
 - Innovative Project Award Winner for the Sidewinder, a tool that is used to fill barriers or berms with compact materials such as gravel, soil, and rocks to control water flow along the roadways.
- **Michael Newell** from the Washington County Department of Public Works, NY
 - Pioneer Award Winner for the Culvert Cleaner, a tool used for clearing out culverts faster and more safely.
