Arizona Chapter of the Associated General

<u>Contractors</u> – Provides workforce development training programs to member firms, government agencies, and individuals.

<u>ConnectU2Jobs (CU2J) Program (txdot.gov)</u> – CU2J is a highway construction workforce partnership pilot program created to fill a need for a skilled highway construction workforce. The focus of CU2J is to connect justice-involved young adults to job training, life skills coaching, and job placement.

Idaho Career Opportunities-Next in Construction

(ICONIC) – Idaho Transportation Department offers an intensive five-week training program where selected applicants receive free hands-on training in heavy equipment operation and cement masonry. North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) On-the-Job Training Program – The NCDOT's On-the-Job Training Program assists minorities, women, veterans, and disadvantaged individuals who have been historically underrepresented in highway construction job opportunities. Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) eLearning – The ODOT Local Technical Assistance Program Center offers many free online courses. Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT)-Bureau of Labor & Industries (BOLI) – ODOT and BOLI have partnered to meet the goals of adding more diversity in hiring, increasing apprenticeship numbers, and providing resources for training. Programs include classes to prepare workers for apprenticeship, resources to pay for child care and travel costs, and training to help people keep respectful work-places. Vermont on the Job Training Program – Training and upgrading of minorities and women toward journeyman status is a primary goal of this Equal Employment Opportunity affirmative action program.

<u>Helmets to Hardhats</u> – Joint labor-management driven entity that connects transitioning active-duty military service members, veterans, National Guard, and Reservists with skilled training and quality career opportunities in the construction industry. <u>Yeah, I Built That</u> – Designed to be a resource for young

people exploring career paths, parents, guidance counselors, teachers, employers, union leaders, and public officials. Crew Collaborative – Shifting the stigma surrounding careers in construction through education, conversation, events, and advocacy. Skill Bridge – Department of Defense Skill Bridge connects transitioning service members with industry partners in real-world job experiences. Future Road Builders Gaming App – Through games, videos, imagery, and assessment tools, this free app explores a virtual highway construction project and uncovers the skills needed to be a heavy and highway construction apprentice. Youth Conservation Corp – Youth employment program that engages young people in meaningful work experiences at national parks, forests, wildlife refuges, and fish hatcheries while developing an ethic of environmental stewardship and civic responsibility.
