




Municipalities with active incentive agreements or TIF districts


77% of municipalities use incentives

600 TIF districts

\$1.4 billion annual TIF extension

\$447 million sum of sales tax rebates' published maximums

\$9 billion market value receiving property tax abatement or incentive classification


