The XRF excites your material sample with a primary X-ray source, then every element present in the sample will produce a set of unique characteristic fluorescent X-rays. Because of XRF's broad range of capabilities, it is important to ensure your sample is representative of the actual source and that the preparation, accessories, and calibration files you use are matched to your unique needs.

XRF can identify most chemical elements, giving it a wide range of applications in transportation materials.
