

- Director, Freight Mobility
 - New position

Freight Mobility Process



- Identify stakeholders (multi-modal)
 - MPO, TxDOT, EHCMA, Harris County, 11 mayors, among others
- Identify projects
- Prioritize projects
- Socialize projects
- Create a plan for development and funding
