
Distribution of Costs on Federal-Aid Highway Construction Contracts Over \$1,000,000 on the National Highway System Reported During Calendar Year 2004



- 1/ Equipment includes fuel and lubricants 61.9%, but excludes operators' and mechanics' wages. Overhead includes contractors' on-site expenses such as mobilization, office, rental, licenses, insurance, etc.
- 2/ Aggregates consists of sand, gravel, slag, crushed stone, etc., For use in bases, portland cement, concrete and bituminous surfaces, and portland cement concrete structures.
- 3/ For both roadway and structures.
- 4/ For various types of bituminous surfaces and bases.
- 5/ Inloudes structural, reinforcing, culvert and miscellaneous stell.
- 6/ Gross earnings of contractors' employees in the following classification: Administrative and Supervisory, Skilled, Intermediate, and Unskilled labor.
