1/ This table is one of a series on State highway finance. Table SF-21 summarizes the State receipts and disbursements for highways shown in Tables SF-1 and SF-2. Tables SF-3, SF-4, and SF-4C provide details on State receipts and expenditures for State roads. Tables SF-5, SF-6, and SF-5A provide details on State receipts and expenditures for local roads. Tables SF-12, SF-12A, and SF-12B provide details on State capital and maintenance expenditures. Tables SF-3B and SF-4B provide details on the receipts and expenditures of individual State toll facilities. This table is compiled from reports of State authorities.

2/ Amounts shown represent only those highway-user revenues that were expended on State or local roads. Amounts expended on nonhighway purposes are excluded. See Table SDF for the full amount and disposition of highway-user revenues, including tolls.

3/ Amounts shown represent gross general fund appropriations for highways reduced by the amount of highway-user revenues placed in the State General Fund. See the "Offset by General Funds Spent for Highways" column on Table DF.
