(3) The data for the territories and Puerto Rico come from the Office of program Administration, FHWA. The data represent the allocations of total obligation authority in SAFETEA-LU for the territorial programs and the Puerto Rico highway program.

(4) Programs discontinued under TEA-21 include ninety percent minimum allocation, donor State bonus, and projects mandated by ISTEA (these projects were identified in Sections 1103-1108 of the Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act (ISTEA) of 1991).
