

Office of Highway Policy Information Gasoline Product Supplied for Fiscal Year Week No. 4 Data complete through 10/22/2021 Excludes Diesel and Alternative Fuels

Gasoline product supplied totaled 2.74 billion gallons in week 4. This is a decrease of -3.23% from the previous week.




Weekly Gasoline Product Supplied

Fiscal Year ▲ 2019 ◆ 2020 ● 2021 ● 2022


Gasoline product supplied compared to the same week last year increased by 9.1% and decreased by -4.71% for the same week two years ago.
