



Gasoline product supplied totaled 2.55 billion gallons in week 2. This is an increase of 4.86% from the previous week.



Gasoline product supplied compared to the same week in FY 2022 decreased by -5.53%, increased by 1.19% for the same week in FY 2021, and decreased by -5.49% for the same week in FY 2019
