


**All vehicle travel** on all interstate highways for Week 16, starting Monday, April 13, 2020, ending Sunday, April 19, 2020, decreased 45% (7.4 billion vehicle miles) as compared with the same week of 2019. Travel for the week is estimated to be 9.1 billion vehicle miles.



**Passenger vehicle travel** on all interstate highways for Week 16, starting Monday, April 13, 2020, ending Sunday, April 19, 2020, decreased 51% as compared with the same week of 2019.

**Truck travel** on all interstate highways for Week 16, starting Monday, April 13, 2020, ending Sunday, April 19, 2020, decreased 16% as compared with the same week of 2019.
