


All vehicle travel on all interstate highways for Week 17, starting Monday, April 20, 2020, ending Sunday, April 26, 2020, decreased 43% (7.1 billion vehicle miles) as compared with the same week of 2019. Travel for the week is estimated to be 9.5 billion vehicle miles.



Passenger vehicle travel on all interstate highways for Week 17, starting Monday, April 20, 2020, ending Sunday, April 26, 2020, decreased 48% as compared with the same week of 2019.

Truck travel on all interstate highways for Week 17, starting Monday, April 20, 2020, ending Sunday, April 26, 2020, decreased 15% as compared with the same week of 2019.
