This is reference to Mr. Tom Deitering's June 19 and July 9, 2007 e-mail correspondence, which forwarded a SEP-14 work plan and related procurement documents, from Pima County, for the use and evaluation of the Job Order Contracting project delivery method.

The County proposes to use the Job Order Contracting technique for the Dodge Boulevard and Sunset Villas Transportation Enhancement projects. To our knowledge, this is the first use of the best value award method (price and non-price factors) for the job order contracting delivery method. The County proposes to award the contract to the highest scoring proposer based on a possible 100 point technical score and a 50 point price score.

You may consider the County's use of the job order contracting concept to be approved for evaluation under SEP-14. Due to the relatively small size of this project, only one evaluation report is required - an initial/final combined report.
