This is in reference to Randy Jensen's January 31 email that forwarded a request from the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) to evaluate the ID/IQ delivery method on a programmatic basis for various water quality and erosion control regional contracts under SEP-14.

Under this method, firms will be bidding on estimated quantities of work to maintain, improve or install stormwater best management practice facilities at permitted locations. This work is necessary to meet the requirements of a stormwater quality permit after the construction project has been completed.
