The Transportation Commission of Wyoming submits herewith an application for right-of-way, and requests issuance of a Letter of Consent (LOC) to transfer federally controlled public lands under the jurisdiction of the Bureau of Land Management with the provisions of Section 317, Title 23, U.S. Code (Highways) approved August 27, 1958, (72 Stat. 885), and nondiscrimination assurance according to Title VI, Civil Rights Act 1964.

When the LOC is issued we will prepare the Highway Easement Deed. Provisions of the National Environmental Policy Act, the Historical Preservation Act and the Preservation of Parklands have been complied with during the planning of this project.
